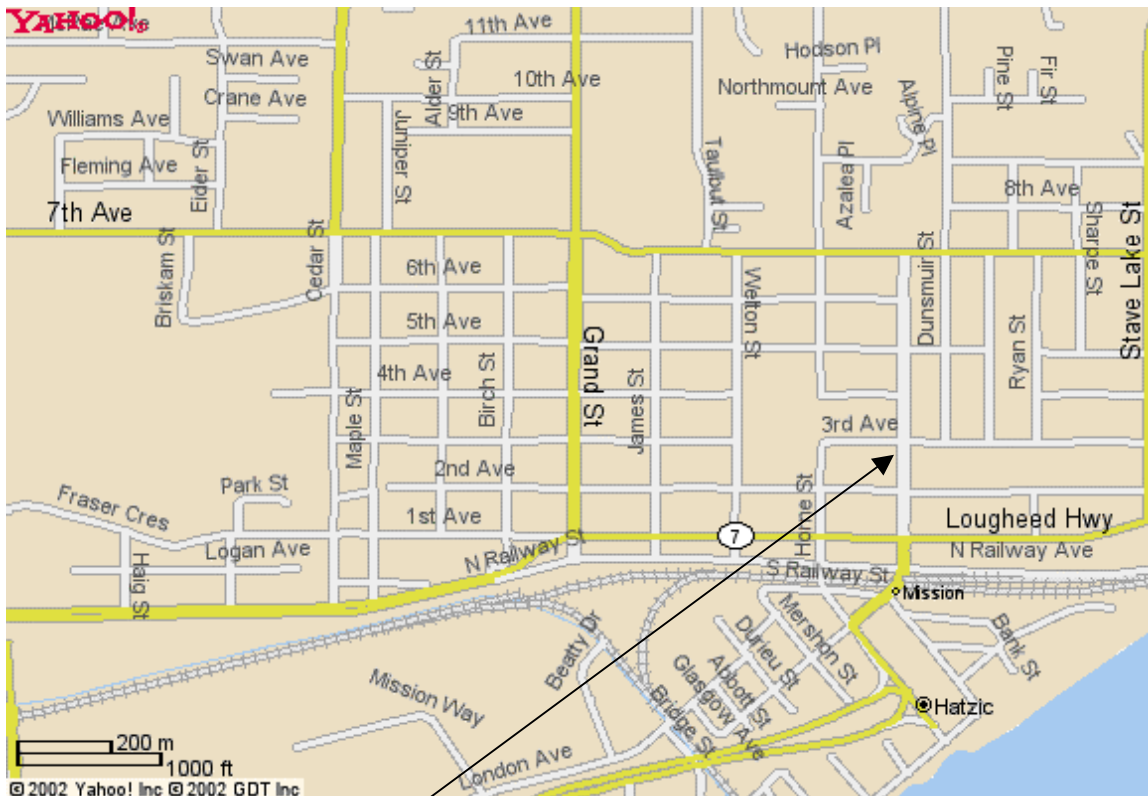


Direction to Stave Lake Lodge Camp



The red star in the middle of the above map is the position of Stave Lake Lodge/Camp. Direction from Richmond/Vancouver is as followed:

- Get on to Hwy 1 heading east, driving for about 1 hour.
- Take Exit 92, get on to Hwy 11 heading north to Mission, follow the signs along the road, driving for ½ hour.
- As you cross the long bridge over Fraser River to Mission, follow the signs to go into downtown Mission. When you see Hwy 7 sign, go straight pass the intersection onto Murrey Street.
- Drive for a few minutes then turn left at 7th Avenue



This is Murrey Street...

- Drive for 1-2 minutes on 7th Ave. then turn right at Cedar Street (see above map)
- Drive for 3-4 minutes, at the end of Cedar Street (just passed a Husky Gas station on the right), turn left onto Dewney Trunk Road (see below map)



- Drive for 1 minute, watch out on the right side for a T intersection (nga ba), Dewney Trunk will turn at a 90° heading north (at the corner is a sight for landfill area), if you miss the turn and go straight, you'll drive onto Keystone Avenue (see map above).
- As you head north on Dewney Trunk for 10 minutes, you'll see the landfill on the left side, continue on for another 5 minutes, you will drive on top of the Stave Lake Dam. Just pass it on the right side is Burma Road. About 100 meter into the road is a guarding post and main gate, if the guard ask where you're going, tell him you're going to Stave Lake Lodge/Camp. Drive for another 3 minutes, you'll see the camp entry on the right (and another gate – you'll have to get out of your vehicle to open the gate and drive pass – please close the gate after going through)
- If you got to the camp after 10:00pm at night, the main gate will be locked. You'll have to call 604-462-7098 to get someone to open the gate for you. (Cellular phone doesn't work inside the camping area, on Dewney Trunk Road, sometimes it works, sometimes it).

Camp regulations (set up by BC Hydro, not by us – violation will result in eviction from the premises and forfeiture of the deposit):

- No alcohol permitted on BC Hydro property
- No pets allowed.
- No tents on play ground (grassy area)
- No parking in fire lanes
- Gates must be closed and locked after each and every use
- No loud noise after 10:00pm
- The phone inside the lodge is for incoming calls and emergency outgoing calls only, LONG DISTANCE CALLS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- No smoking inside the lodge.
- Fires are restricted to the 2 designated fire circles on the lakeside – fire must be attended.
- Lots of firewood are pre-cut already, cutting of trees are not allowed.
- No shoes inside the lodge.
- No candles inside the lodge, they may set the sensitive fire alarm off – only fire department has key to turn the system off.
- Garbage and refuse must be put inside the two steel bins (to discourage animals from coming into the camp to look for foods), and camp worker will collect them every day before sunset.
